

4 Day Tanzania Luxury Safari to Tarangire, Ngorongoro Crater and Lake Manyara

Enjoy authentic interactions with the Maasai, See the big cats, and See more animals than you ever thought possible as you game drive through the Lake Manyara Park, Tarangire national park, Ngorongoro Conservation area and highlands.

Day 1-Arusha

On arrival at Kilimanjaro Airport or Arusha Airport you will be met by our representative. The transfer to your lodge will be a 30 mins drive. Dinner and overnight ***Lake Duluti Serena Lodge or similar Accommodation HB.***

Day 2-Tarangire National Park

After breakfast departs for your 3-4 hours' drive, a stopover in Arusha Town for any last minute purchases .in Tarangire National Park a game drive with picnic lunch will give you an unrivaled experience. Tarangire is well known for its baobab trees and being an elephant hub. It forms the centre of an annual migratory cycle that includes up to 3000 elephants, 25,000 wildebeest and 30,000 zebras. Dinner and overnight at ***Manyara Serena Lodge or similar***

Day 3-Lake Manyara National Park

After breakfast the tour departs for a 2- 3 hours' drive to Manyara National Park. The first stop is Arusha Town for any last minute purchases before we head off on to Lake Manyara. Lake Manyara National Park offers breathtaking views and a large variety of habitats with its Acacia woodlands, water forests, baobab strewn cliffs, algae-streaked hot springs, swamps and the lake itself. This the small Park is able to support a large number of animal species and incredible bird life. Manyara has the largest concentration of baboons anywhere in the world and the lions here are also renowned for their tree climbing skills. Dinner and overnight at ***Ngorongoro Serena Lodge***

Day 4-Ngorongoro Crater – Arusha – Airport drop off

After an early breakfast, you will descend over 600 meters into the crater to view wildlife. Supported by a year round water supply and fodder, the Ngorongoro conservation Area supports a vast variety of animals, which include herds of wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, eland, warthog, hippo and giant African elephants. Another big draw card to this picturesque national park, is its dense population of

predators, which include lions, hyenas, jackals, cheetahs and the ever-elusive leopard, which sometimes requires a trained eye to spot. We will visit Lake Magadi, a large but shallow alkaline lake in the southwestern corner, which is one of the main features of the crater. A large number of flamingos, hippos and other water birds can usually be seen here. Late afternoon transfer to Arusha it will be a 4 hours' drive. Dinner and Overnight or airport drop off. (Accommodation can be included upon request at extra cost)
